# Introduction

The Ninety-Third Legislature reconvened February 12, 2024, with one change in the caucus leadership of the Minnesota Senate.

Senator Erin P. Murphy (DFL-St. Paul) was named Majority Leader and Chair of the Committee on Rules and Administration, replacing Senator Kari Dziedzic.

Senator Mark T. Johnson (R-East Grand Forks) continued as Minority Leader.

Senator Bobby Joe Champion (DFL-Minneapolis) continued as President of the Senate.

The political makeup of the 2024 Senate remained 34 DFL and 33 Republican senators.

The Senate adjourned sine die on the 119th legislative day, Sunday, May 19, 2024. The House of Representatives adjourned sine die on the 120th legislative day, Monday, May 20, 2024.

Senator Kelly L. Morrison (DFL-Deephaven) resigned effective June 6, 2024, to run for the U.S. House of Representatives in the third congressional district. A special election to fill the vacancy in District 45 will be held during the general election on November 5, 2024.
